Members must show in at least 1 Premium class to receive their premium for the project. Premium classes are 1-9.

2. Showmanship 13 & under
3. Trail In Hand 14 & over
4. Trail In Hand 13 & under
5. Jumper 38" & under (equine must be 3yrs or older)
6. Hunter 38" & under (equine must be 3yrs or older)
7. Pleasure Driving
8. Driving Reinsmanship
  
9. Ground driving Reinsmanship *-Horse & Handler may not be entered in any cart driving class*
10. Bribery barrels – enter the ring, remove lead and bribe your equine around the barrel pattern with a carrot or treat. Timed event
11. Horse Smarts -(obstacles and equine questions. Know things from your book Parts, breed requirements, colors, grooming tools, Quality Assurance, etc.)
12. Liberty? -TBD
13. Mystery class
14. Costume Class
15. Trick pony

All youth 19 & under must wear proper helmet at any equestrian activity while riding or driving according to the most current Uniform Rules for 4-H horse shows, pg. 6, General rule #1.

You must use your 4-H project small equine.

A current accident release form must be on file.

4-H Horse Safety Requirements completed and 4-H permission to Participate form signed. All Judges' decisions are Final.

Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows will be the rulebook used at all 4-H shows. If not in the 4-H rules the class will follow ASPC/AMHR or ADS Rules.
