Richland County Horse Royalty Code of Conduct

Each year up to four youth are selected as the ambassadors and runners up for the horse royalty of the Richland County Junior Fair. The purpose of this contest is to recognize youth who best reflect 4-H and/or FFA, plus the overall Junior Fair program. 4-H and FFA members learn leadership, citizenship, and life skills. Representatives of the royalty will demonstrate growth in these areas in addition to demonstrating a well-rounded Junior Fair career that included participation in a variety of Junior Fair activities, project growth, and diversity in the type of projects taken

If chosen to represent Richland County as a royalty member, I _____,
agree to abide by these guidelines set forth by the Richland County Barn Raisers Committee:

1. I will gladly accept the title I am awarded (including the given attire) and conduct myself in a courteous and respectful manner, exhibit good sportsmanship and provide a positive role model for all youth.
2. I will not talk in a negative way about anyone associated with the royalty selection process of participants. I will also encourage others to be supportive of the overall program.
3. I will respect, adhere to, and enforce the rules, policies, and guidelines as established by the Richland County Junior Fair program.
4. I will not use tobacco, alcohol, or any type of illegal drug, plus engage in inappropriate behavior.
5. I will be a positive role model for other Junior Fair exhibitors keeping in mind younger exhibitors will observe my dress and behavior and look up to me. I will show no public display of affection (PDA) while in attire or inappropriate affection when not in attire.
6. I will dress in a fashion that positively represents the Richland County Junior Fair. This includes following the Junior Fair dress code for all events and refraining from public displays of affection during the county fair, parades, and other related events. Attire while representing the horse royalty will include business casual dress. Clean, respectable jeans and collared shirts with a hat are considered appropriate dress while passing out awards and going to public appearances. Please no jeans with holes, cuts, duct tape, or rips. Skirts and shorts must be fingertip length and all tops should have sleeves and show no midriff or excessive cleavage. See Junior Fair rules for dress code and ore information. I will stand, stia and offer positive physical behavior appropriate to my dress, situation, and role.
7. I will work with members of the royalty committee to make sure that representatives of the court are available to present awards at horse events during the fair and at events after the fair has been completed.
8. I will hold this title with respect and honor and be proud to represent the Richland County Junior Fair program.

If I feel I can not agree to these guidelines I should not go through the interview and testing process. If at any time a legitimate complaint is filed against me, it will be discussed with me. Failure to follow the guidelines above, could result in the forfeiture of my title and all prizes and appearances.
